**Where will you get your information:**

- ❖ CD-ROM: Save in Notepad form
- ❖ Books: Type into notepad and save, or straight into multimedia program.
- ❖ By faxing or phoning an expert and taking notes
- ❖ By e-mailing an expert

**CONTENT: In the project you will have:**

- ❖ 4 pages max or 3 minimum total allowed.
- ❖ Each page will have buttons to navigate your pages.
- ❖ A voice over on the title page (20secs) to 'advertise' your topic.
- ❖ A short introduction to them
- ❖ Explanation and supporting information on why you chose them to represent courage. (1-2 paragraphs). This will be MANIPULATED text combined from electronic sources, with your own words.
- ❖ Other information: Collected from interviews, books etc. This must also focus on 'courage'
- ❖ 3 pictures (1 x clipart, 1 from a CD-ROM, 1 from Internet)
