



HUMAN FACTORS


Wahine

Choose the most important ones to list.

Titanic

- Lookout didn't spot iceberg early enough.
- Captain was sailing ship too fast.
- They thought it was unsinkable so didn't take enough care (e.g. shortage of lifeboats)

- Captain backed boat onto reef.
- Order to abandon came late.
- Starboard" call led to confusion. People didn't know what it meant.
